THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD Text: John 9

Introduction:

- 1. There Are Two Competing Belief Systems...
 - a. The World's System: Self Worth = Performance + Other's Opinions
 - 1) My Value is Determined by How much a Excel in something
 - 2) and what other people's opinions are about me
 - b. God's System: Self Worth = What God Says About You
 - 1) Not What Others Say About You—but What God Says About You!
 - 2) My Value is from God's Love and Purpose for me
- 2. This is Why So Many People Who Live For Other's Acceptance, Die by their Rejection.
- 3. We Are About to Meet a Man Born Blind...
 - a. And Before it's all over, He Will Be Rejected by His Parents,
 - b. Mocked and Scorned by the Powerful Pharisees
 - c. And Yet He Defends Jesus Christ Against their Attacks! —In Other Words...

In the End He Doesn't Need the Acceptance of his Parents <u>or</u> Approval of the Pharisees
—> <u>Because Jesus Had Opened His Eyes!</u>

I. THE MIRACLE

A. BLINDNESS OF THE BEGGAR

- 1. BLIND FROM BIRTH (v.1-5)
 - a) When Faced with What We Do Not Understand—We Often Ask the Wrong Question "Who Sinned, this man or his parents, that he would be born blind?"
 - b) We Tend To Assign Guilt to Human Suffering (like Job's friends did)
 - c) But Jesus Opens the Eyes of their Ignorance—But then He does something about it The Question is NOT Why is there Suffering—but What Will We Do About It?
 - d) Notice the Contrast:
 - They are in the Dark—Jesus is the Light
 - They are Focusing on the Physical—Jesus focuses on the Spiritual
 - They are looking for Fault in the Past—Jesus looks at Opportunity for the Future!
- 2. BLIND BUT HEALED BY CHRIST (v.6-12)
 - a) He Spits on the Ground! Then Makes Mud w/ the Saliva, Then Rubs it on his eyes!
 - b) Then Sends Him to the Pool of Siloam (Without Leading Him by the Hand!)
 - c) But This Man Will TRUST and OBEY
- 3. BLIND BUT NOW HE CAN SEE (v.13-17)
 - a) There is a Great Division Among the People Over Jesus
 - b) Some Say He's a Sinner for Healing on Sabbath / Others say a sinner can't heal!
 - c) But There is Not Division in this man's heart! He Was Blind But Now He Sees!

B. BLINDNESS OF THE PARENTS

1. THE BLINDNESS OF FEAR (9:18-23)

- a) The Pharisees Were Very Powerful
 - (1) They Had the Power of Ex-Communication
 - (2) To Be Banned from the Synagogue and Temple was unthinkable for devout Jew
- b) To be Ex-Communicated was to be labeled an "Anathema" Means: Accursed
- c) Rejection of the Jewish Rulers, Rejection of Friends, Family, Community...

Cut Off — Persona non grata — you don't exist.

2. THEY FEARED RELIGIOUS AND SOCIAL REJECTION...

- a) To the Point of Rejecting The Truth that their Son was Healed by Christ!
- b) Today it is the Peer Pressure of a Woke Mob,

Rejection of the Popular People

The desire to be accepted by the Powerful People

c) This Fear Causes Us to Be Blind to the Truth

C. BLINDNESS OF THE PHARISEES

1. BLINDNESS OF PRIDE (9:24-30)

- a) They Refuse to Believe and Are Trying to Discredit this Man
 - (1) Accusing him of Deception
 - (2) Intimidating his Family
 - (3) Dismiss Him with Insults
 - (4) They Do Not Want to Believe!
- b) Yet, The Man Healed by Christ Won't Back Down!

2. THE PHARISEES ARE REVEALING HOW BLIND THEY ARE! (9:31-34)

a) He Points Out the Very Evidence They Are Unwilling to See!

3. WHO IS TRULY BLIND?

- a) They Refuse to Admit They Are Wrong...
- b) So They Do What Many People Do When Proven Wrong...
 - (1) FIRST: They Insulted Him
 - (2) SECOND: Try to Discredit Him: Accuse him of being born in sin
 - (3) THIRD: They cast him out... (9:34) "You were completely born in sins, and are you teaching us?" And they cast him out."

D. BLINDNESS OF UNBELIEF

1. HE IS CAST OUT BUT JESUS FINDS THE MAN HIMSELF! (9:35-41)

"The Jews cast him out of the Temple; the Lord of the Temple found him." (Chrysostom)

2. Jesus Asks a Simple, Profound Question:

'Do You Believe in the Son of God?'

- a) The man gives a simple & profound answer: 'Lord, I believe'.
- b) And he fell down and worshipped Him This is the Journey of Faith!
 - (1) The man born blind began saying "A man called Jesus... opened my eyes"
 - (2) When they asked him again, he said, "He is a Prophet"
 - (3) And now, He Truly Sees "Lord, I believe"

II. THE IMPLICATIONS...

A. SPIRITUAL BLINDNESS IS REAL

- 1. Many Types of Spiritual Blindness...
 - (1) Fear Like These Parents...
 - (2) Anger and Hate (6) Jealousy
 - (3) Ignorance (7) Ambition
 - (4) Pride

2. Six Days before Jesus would be Betrayed, Mary Broke open a jar of Costly fragrant oil, and she poured it on Jesus feet

- a) It was an Extravagant Gift—so expensive it was worth 300 Denarii (a year's wages)
- b) But Judas Didn't See the Precious Act of Giving from the heart...
- c) His Bitterness Had Warped His Vision so Much, that he was Angry!
- d) Why This Waste? Why Wasn't This Sold for 300 denarii and given to the Poor!
 - -> I'm the good person here, Mary is the one who doesn't Care about the Poor!

(5) Selfishness

- 3. But John tells us something revealing (John 12:4-6)
 - a) Matthew tells us Something Else Even More Revealing...
 - b) Notice what happened immediately after this incident (Matthew 26:14-16)
- 4. When Judas Went out to Betray Jesus it was night (John 13:30)
 - a) It is always night when people go from Christ to follow their own purposes.
 - b) It is always night when people listen to the call of evil rather than the call of good.
 - c) It is always night when hate puts out the light of love.
 - d) It is always night when people turn their backs on Jesus. (Barclay)
- 5. Spiritual Blindness is Real—and it's Effects Are Real

B. SPIRITUAL BLINDNESS IS A CHOICE

- 1. We Might Call it: BEING IN DENIAL...
 - a) The Bible Calls it "Decieving Ourselves" SELF-DECEPTION (1 John 1:5-7)
 - b) The Bible Also Calls it "Willful Ignorance"
- 2. There Comes a Point Where Spiritual Blindness Becomes a Choice...
 - a) The Choice to Believe in God-or Not Believe in God
 - b) To Obey God—or Reject God
 - c) To Accept God-or Deny God
- 3. It's Not Intellectual—it is Moral... (2 Thessalonians 2:9–12)
 - a) On the Surface it seems that God is Deceiving people...
 - b) But He is Not! They Are Deceiving themselves!
 - c) HOW? God Has Given Us All Free-will Choice...
 - (1) To Love the TRUTH or the LIE
 - (2) To Love the LIGHT or the DARKNESS
 - (3) To Love GOD or UNRIGHTEOUSNESS
- 4. The Veil is Taken Away When a Person Turns to Christ (2 Cor. 3:14–16)

C. JESUS IS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

39 And Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind."

- 1. The Greatest Deception of Mankind Fall on Those
 Who Think They See but Are Spiritually Blind...
 - a) Blind to our own Blindness...
 - b) Thinking We See, But Are Blind
 - c) Thinking we are Free, But Actually Enslaved
 - d) Thinking we are Saved, When we are actually Lost
- 2. This is Happening to People All Over the World! (2 Corinthians 4:3–4)
- 3. In God's Wisdom, He Chose to Reveal His Message
 - a) to those who have a humble, child-like heart
 - b) But in a way that would't appeal to those who are wise in their own eyes!

 (Matthew 11:25-26)
- 4. What a Blessing That He Has Opened Our Eyes! (Luke 10:23–24)

CONCLUSION:

In the End the Blind Man Didn't Need the Acceptance of his Parents or Approval of the Pharisees...

Because Jesus Had Opened His Eves!

- 1. "How completely satisfying to turn from our limitations, to a God who has none." (AW Tozer)
- 2. John 8:12
