- 3. Jesus Has No Choice But to Condemn Her to Death for the Sin of Adultery

 OR Jesus would be breaking the Law of Moses.
 - a) Jesus Bent Down and Began Writing with His Finger on the Ground
 - b) We Have No Idea What He Wrote! But Whatever it was... one by one the men dropped their rocks and slowly walked away
- 4. Jesus Neither Condemned Her, Nor Condoned Her Sin—
 He Simply Asked Where are your Accusers?
 - a) Without 2 or 3 witnesses, they could not carry out the death penalty under the Law
- 5. Jesus Gave this Woman a Another Chance, a New Start
 - a) He did not condone her sin-He said Go and Sin No More
 - b) But Jesus Knew He would Die on the cross for the sins of the whole world

B. APPLICATION:

- 1. Jesus Has Given Us Grace by His Blood Shed on the Cross
- 2. Grace Does NOT Condone Sin! 'Go and Sin no more'
- 3. But Grace Forgives Sin! and Gives Us a New Start!

A New Life! A New Hope! A New Future!

7. JESUS KNOWS OUR PAST – BUT ALSO OUR POTENTIAL

A. EXAMPLE: Peter boasted he would never deny Jesus (Matt. 26:33-35)

- 1. Jesus had even told Peter He Would Deny Him 3 times
- 2. Jesus said if we Deny His name before men, He Will Deny Us before the Father in heaven! —Peter did that!
- 3. But Jesus told Peter, When you have returned, strength your brethren
- 4. Jesus went to Peter personally and asked Peter 'Do you love me' 3x!
- 5. Peter said, You know I love you, you know all things...

Jesus said: Then feed my sheep (John 21:17)

B. JESUS HELPS US TODAY...

- 1. Jesus Knows Your Past—But He Also Knows Your Potential!
- 2. He wants you to be saved! to be forgiven!
- 3. to be set free and washed clean by the blood He shed at the cross!
- 4. He Shed His Blood to Forgive You
- 5. He Gave us the Truth to Set You Free—Truth is the fiery core of counseling
- 6. He Gives us wisdom if we would ask

CONCLUSION:

- 1. You can search all of the worlds religions, philosophies, ideologies but you CANNOT find GRACE in ANY OF THEM
- 2. Only Christ can Set You Free from the guilt and condemnation of sin
