LUKE—A Glimpse Into Eternity Text: Lk 16:19–31 Bill Turner

Sixty Seconds After Death

1. What happens 60 seconds after we die? Is it possible to even know?

- a. Barna Group has been polling Americans for Decades...in 2013...64% believed the soul survives after death / 68% of Americans Believe Heaven Exists / 58% that Hell exists
- 2. It is extremely rare that we would get a glimpse into eternity...
 - a. Jesus gives us a glimpse behind the veil of death—a glimpse into eternity

I. WE SEE THE LIFE AND DEATH OF TWO MEN... (v.19–23)

A. <u>A RICH MAN</u> (v.19) <---

- 1. Notice His Clothes... In ancient times Purple was the garment of royalty
 - a) It was also what the High Priest wore / as well as the rich religious rulers
 - b) Purple Dye was extracted from a marine shellfish in the Aegean Sea
 - c) It took 12,000 shellfish to obtain only 1.4 grams of purple dye
 - d) It was Rare and Expensive—a sign of wealth and power
- 2. Notice His Food... ESV "who feasted sumptuously every day"
- 3. Notice It is EVERY DAY... NIV: He "lived in luxury every day"
 - a) NASB He was "joyously living in splendor every day"
- 4. He Lived a Lavish Life the 'Lifestyles of the Rich and Famous'
 - a) Beautiful Clothes... beautiful house... beautiful life...
 - b) but there was one evesore There was a beggar at the gate...

B. A MAN NAMED LAZARUS (v.20-21) <----

- 1. He Was Hungry: The rich man feasted everyday
 - but Lazarus could only hope for crumbs from the rich man's table
- 2. He Was Sick: The Rich man was covered in Fine Linen-
 - Lazarus is covered in sores / bleeding ulcers all over his body
- **3. He Was Alone:** The Rich Man would've had friends—but Lazarus has no one He was laid at the gate of the rich man for help
- 4. He Was Weak: The rich man was free to do what he wanted—
 - But Lazarus could't even keep the dogs from licking his sores

C. TWO DIFFERENT MEN, TWO DIFFERENT LIVES—BOTH DIED (v.22-23)<---

- 1. They Both Died and I'm Sure the Rich Man Had a Great Funeral Service
 - a) Full of Compliments and Catered Food Afterwards
- 2. But Their Situation Completely Reverses...
 - a) Now the Poor Man is Blessed—and the Rich Man is Destitute
 - b) Now the Suffering Man is Comforted—but the Comfortable Man is Tormented
- 3. Everyone Expected the Poor, Weak man to Die—but not the Rich man
 - a) All His Wealth, Money, Influence and Power Could Not save him from Death.
 - b) He Too Died and Suddenly Found Himself in Torment in Hades
- 4. The Greek Word <u>HADES</u> literally means: "That which is not seen"
 - a) It is Greek Equivalent of O.T. Hebrew word Sheol—both mean: "The Realm of the Dead"

II. WE SEE A GLIMPSE INTO ETERNITY... (v.24-31)

Notice what Death Cannot Do —

A. DEATH DOES NOT DESTROY CONSCIOUSNESS

- 1. The Rich Man and Lazarus are Dead—but they are entirely alive!
 - a) No "soul-sleep" ... or unconscious state
 - b) No "annihilation" from Existence
 - c) No "absorption" into some impersonal energy life force

2. They Are Fully Conscious and Fully aware

- a) The Sadducees Did NOT Believe in life after death—so they debated w/ Jesus
- b) Jesus referred them to God telling Moses, "I Am the God of Abraham, the God of Issac and the God of Jacob..."
- c) Abraham Issac and Jacob had already Died! But They Were Not Dead...
- d) "God is not God of the Dead-but of the living"

B. DEATH DOES NOT DESTROY IDENTITY

1. Not Only Were They Still Alive—they Retained their Identity

- a) The Rich Man Knew Who Lazarus Was; Who Abraham Was; Who his brothers were
- b) Lazarus is still Lazarus... The Rich Man Still the Rich Man... Abraham still Abraham

2. There is No Identity Theft With God

- a) In This world people use identity theft to steal money or Escape Justice
- b) NAZI Hunters have searched Argentina for NAZI War Criminals who altered their ID
- c) They Wanted to Escape Justice—but No One Can Fake Their Identity w/ God

3. Death Does Not Destroy Identity—

a) the lost will have to live w/ themselves for eternity

C. DEATH DOES NOT DESTROY MEMORY

- 1. In Hades, the Rich Man wanted relief... but Abraham said... 'Son, remember'
 - a) He remembered who Lazarus was
 - b) He remembered who his brothers were
 - c) Abraham had him recall what kind of person he was and the life he led

2. His memory was not wiped — his memory was clear

- a) The Memory of the Saved will Magnify their Joy and Appreciation
- b) But the Memory of the Lost will intensify their Regret

D. DEATH DOES NOT DESTROY PERSONALITY

- 1. The Rich Man is Still Ordering Lazarus Around!
 - a) Go Tell Lazarus to Get Me Some Water...

2. THEN He's Arguing with Abraham about how to Reach his Brothers!

- a) No Abraham, You Don't Understand—If They See a Ghost—then they'll believe!
- b) NO RICH MAN, You Don't Get It... Even After the Grave You STILL Don't Get It...

3. Paul said, Faith, Hope and Love, but the greatest of these is Love

- a) Why? Because Faith and Hope will be Fulfilled—but Love is Eternal
- b) In Heaven we bring Our Self-Sacrificing Love with Us!
- c) May it be a part of our heart and personality by then!

E. DEATH DOES NOT DESTROY DESTINY

- 1. Jesus Clearly Teaches There Are Only Two Destinations after this life...
 - a) Lazarus was carried by the Angels to a Place of COMFORT
 - b) The Rich Man Lifted Up His Eyes in TORMENT
 - c) There is a Great Gulf (Greek: Chasma [English: Chasm]) Separating Them)
- 2. Death Does Not Destroy Our Eternal Destination—It SEALS It
 - a) This Side is the Only Side of Eternity We Can Seek Salvation
 - b) After the Grave it is Too Late
- 3. Heaven is Real and Hell is Real—we will be in one of those places for eternity

III. WE SEE SOME FACTS TO REMEMBER

A. JESUS NEVER TAUGHT A 'PROSPERITY GOSPEL'

- 1. The Pharisees loved money and created their own prosperity theology...
 - a) A 'Reality Distortion Field' giving the illusion of serving God & money
 - b) That if you just have enough faith—your Faith Can Make You Rich!
 - c) If You Just Have Enough Faith in What You WANT-You Can Manifest it
- 2. In a prosperity gospel—the rich man is saved and the poor man is lost!
 - a) Jesus said: 'It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the Kingdom of God' (Lk 18:24-27)
- 3. Does that sound like a prosperity 'Health and Wealth' Prosperity Gospel?
 - a) Why would God intentionally give you something that could cost your soul?
 - b) Why Would He have said: You Cannot Serve both God and Money?
- 4. The Deception of <u>RICHES</u> is that it is <u>special favor from God</u>
 The Deception of <u>SUFFERING</u> is that it is <u>a Curse from God</u>
 - a) But the Bible explains why WE LIVE IN A BROKEN WORLD...
 - b) Because of Sin—We Are No Longer in the Garden of Eden
 - c) Bad things happen to good people & Good things happen to Bad people
 - d) This world is scarred by Sin, Suffering, Disease and Death

B. GOD HAS NOT FORGOTTEN YOU

- 1. Lazarus was Sick and Suffering Dogs Licked his sores...
 - a) Destitute and Hungry Hoping just for crumbs from the rich man's table
 - b) But Lazarus was NOT Forgotten!
 - c) He was Received into glory by the angels of God!
- 2. Think of the Apostles Who Were Personally Chosen & Trained by Jesus... for 3 years to spread the gospel good news to the world But They Were Tortured and Killed for the Faith!
 - <u>Mathew</u> was martyred in Ethiopia—killed by the sword
 - Mark was dragged behind horses in Alexandria, Egypt
 - Luke was hung in Greece for preaching the gospel
 - <u>John</u> banished as a prisoner to the island of Patmos

- Peter was crucified upside down by his tormentors by his request...
 because he didn't feel worthy to be killed like Christ
- Paul was beheaded in Rome
- 3. Yet when Jesus gave them the great commission to preach the gospel: He said: 'I will be with you always, even unto the end of the world!' (Mt 28:20)
- 4. Whatever your going through—God has not forgotten you!
 - a) God Will Avenge the blood of the Martyrs and prophets
 - b) And He Will Comfort His People (Psalm 34:18-19; Psalm 147:3-6)

C. <u>DEATH IS AN ETERNAL EVENT HORIZON</u>...

- 1. In Astronomy, an Event Horizon is defined as: 'a theoretical boundary around a black hole beyond which no light or other radiation can escape. A point of no return' (Oxford American Dictionary)
- 2. Death is an Eternal Event Horizon: a spiritual boundary event of no return
- 3. Once we cross the plane of that event horizon—our destination is sealed "it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment (Heb. 9:27)
- 4. Even with the Judgement Day is still future—they knew their destination
- 5. And there was a Great Gulf Between them—that cannot be crossed
- D. <u>FAITH COMES FROM THE WORD OF GOD</u> (Romans 10:17)

 Not From Visions or Aberrations or Para-Normal Experiences
 - 1. Notice What the Rich Man Says to Abraham... (16:27–30)
 - b. Abraham Tells Him—They Have Moses and the Prophets—God's Inspired Word
 - c. NO Father Abraham... No That's Not Enough
 - d. But if You Send Some one from the Dead—Then They Will Listen!
 - 2. It is Interesting how some people will believe anything BUT the Truth!
 - a) A Ghost... a Dream... a Psychic... Aliens? But the Bible?!

 No no no... ANYTHING BUT THAT...
 - b) if You Bring Someone Back from the Dead—Then They will Believe (v.29-31)
 - 3. How Interesting—that not long after Jesus gave this Parable...
 - —Jesus brought someone back from the dead—His Name Was Lazarus!
 - a) Did the Chief Priests and Rulers Believe? The Pharisees and Sadducees Believe?
 - b) NO—from that Day Forward they Plotted to Kill Jesus-
 - -and Destroy the Evidence by Trying to kill Lazarus as well!

CONCLUSION:

- 1. Jesus left the glory of heaven to humble Himself in Human form
 - a) He suffered unspeakable torment on the Cross-
 - b) He Willingly Crossed the Event Horizon of Death—so you could have Eternal Life
 - c) We Also cross that Event Horizon spiritually when we're buried w/ Him in Baptism
 - d) To be Born again to new life! And Now He now Lives to Make Intercession for You!
- 2. In This World You Will Have Trials and Tribulation—But Fear Not... Be of Good Cheer—He Has Overcome the World!
- 3. (Revelation 21:4) He Will Make All Things New!
