FOCUSING ON HEAVEN Text: Hebrews 11:8-16

The Home of the Soul

Introduction:

- 1. Following God by Faith is not always easy—Especially during difficult times
 - a. There is a longing of the human spirt—for eternal life
 - b. "If we find ourselves with a desire that nothing in this world can satisfy, the most probable explanation is that we were made for another world." (C.S. Lewis)
- 2. Focusing on heaven can help us through the difficult times... that's what

Abraham did—He focused on heaven (Hebrews 11:8–10, 13-16)

- a. There's a lot about heaven we don't know... we have questions...
- b. But God has revealed some wonderful things about heaven to Help us and Prepare us

1. IS HEAVEN REAL?

A. HEAVEN IS REAL

1. I've never been to the city of Tokyo...

But I have faith Tokyo exists, even though I've never seen it.

- a) I've never SCUBA dived the tropical waters or coral reefs of the South Pacific
- b) I've never visited deep space galaxies—or other planets, But I have faith they exist
- c) But My Faith is not a blind faith—it is based on evidence
- 2. So it is with heaven—Heaven is real—Whether or not you've been there
 - a) God's Word that tells us Heaven Exists...
 - b) and of some who were allowed to see it! Like Apostle Paul (2 Corinthians 12:2-4)
- 3. The word "heaven" is used in three different ways in the Bible.
 - a) 1st would be: atmospheric heavens—what we would call Earth's atmosphere.
 - b) 2nd: is the **expanse of the heavens**—deep space of planets and stars.
 - c) 3rd: it is used of the **heaven of heavens**—the dwelling place of God.
 - —a spiritual realm outside of space and time.

Of these three heavens, someone said, "The first we see by day, the second we see by night, and the third we see by faith."

B. THE THRONE OF GOD IS THERE

- 1. The Apostle John was allowed to see the Throne of God... (Rev. 4:1-6a)
- 2. His body was on the Island of Patmos—His Spirit was taken up to heaven
- 3. Where he was given a glimpse into the spiritual realm of heaven

C. <u>HEAVEN IS THE DWELLING PLACE OF GOD</u>

- 1. Jesus said, 'in my Father's house' (John 14:1-3)
- 2. Let not your heart be troubled... Believe it!
- 3. There is a beautiful future for God's children

2. WHAT IS HEAVEN LIKE?

God's Word gives us a glimpse into the spiritual realm to show...

A. HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF PEACE AND JOY

- 1. No More Sorrow or Suffering (Revelation 21:4)
 - No More Regrets or Misunderstandings...
 - · No more Broken Relationships or Betrayal
 - · No more Tears or Death

B. HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF BEAUTY AND GLORY

- 1. Heaven is described with incredible beauty and glory (Revelation 22:1–2a)
 - · Heaven is beyond our frame of reference—Beyond our Comprehension
 - So Symbolic language is meant to give our finite minds, a sense of the infinite,
 - using words and ideas that we can understand.
- 2. These rare earth gems were also in the Garden of Eden (Rev 21:18-21, 23)

C. HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF VICTORY

- 1. Victory Over Suffering (Revelation 20:4; 22:5)
- 2. Victory Over Tribulation (Revelation 7:13–17)
- 3. Victory Over Evil (Revelation 12:9–12)

D. HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF WORSHIP & SERVICE

- 1. We See Spiritual Worship in Heaven (Revelation 7:9-12)
- 2. We also see Spiritual Service in Heaven (Revelation 7:15)
- 3. Some people think Heaven will be boring! I don't think so (Rev. 8:3-5)

E. HEAVEN IS A PLACE OF ETERNAL LIFE

- 1. The River of Life flows w/ crystal clear water from the throne of God (22:1)
- 2. The Tree of Life is there (22:2)
- 3. The Crown of Life for those who are faithful unto death (2:10)
- 4. Eternal life in the presence of our eternal Savior (21:6)

3. WHO IS IN HEAVEN?

A. FIRST—THOSE WHO ARE IN HEAVEN

- 1. GOD the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit
- 2. The ANGELS: Created Spiritual beings (Mt 18:10; Rev 7:11-12)
- 3. The REDEEMED Who have already gone before us (Revelation 7:9-10)

B. <u>SECOND—THOSE WHO ARE NOT IN HEAVEN</u>

- 1. Not everyone who call on the name of Jesus (Matthew 7:21)
 - a) Some think all they have to do is Believe in Jesus...
 - b) But even the demons believe, and tremble! (James 2:19)
 - c) Faith without works is dead (James 2:24)

- 2. Not everyone who does good works (Matthew 7:22-23)
 - a) These people believed and did good works
 - b) But good works is not enough to earn your way to heaven
- 3. Only Those Who Do The Will of the Father in Heaven... (Matthew 7:21)
 - a) Is this Legalism? NO!
 - b) Legalism is salvation by perfect law-keeping, thinking you earned salvation.

"Righteousness is what is on the inside, Legalism is what you see on the outside" (Willis Warmuth, Rogue River church of Christ)

4. AM I GOOD ENOUGH TO GO TO HEAVEN?

A. IS BEING GOOD ENOUGH—GOOD ENOUGH?

- 1. Most People assume that we will go to heaven if we are good enough.
 - a) A Barna poll found that 63 percent of the U.S. population thinks that if a person is good enough, he can earn his way to heaven.
- 2. USA TODAY asked: "What are your chances of going to heaven?"
 - a) A middle-aged man from Illinois said his *chances were "50–50. The older I get, the more I think my chances will improve."*
 - b) A young woman from Indiana said, "My chances are kind of slim—maybe 50–50.

 You have to be more than a nice person. But I'm still in the running."
 - c) A Florida man was pretty laid back about it: "Eighty-five percent. I don't think the entrance exam will be that tough."
- 3. Do you See the Problem? They are gauging their chances of going to heaven in terms of how good they perceive themselves to be.1
 - a) Like a scale: I was 49% bad but 51% good tips the scales.

B. <u>BEING GOOD ENOUGH—IS NOT GOOD ENOUGH</u>

- 1. No One is good enough—it only takes one sin to keep you out of heaven
 - a) "For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all." (James 2:10)
 - b) We have all sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Rom. 3:23)
- 2. Sin is the One Thing Not Allowed in Heaven! (Revelation 21:27 ESV)
- 3. And Our Own Self-Righteousness cannot Atone for our own sins
- 4. Even if you Piled up all your Self-Righteousness you've ever done —all you have is a pile of filthy rags. (Isaiah 64:6)
- 5. We need True Righteousness—not self-righteousness
- 6. A Righteousness that only God can provide (Isaiah 61:10)

5. HOW CAN I HAVE THE HOPE OF HEAVEN?

A. BY THE BLOOD OF THE LAMB!

- 1. Only the Blood of Jesus Can Provide Atonement for Our Sins (Rev. 1:5-6)
- 2. The Only Way Anyone Can Have the Hope of Heaven is by the Blood of the Lamb (Revelation 7:13–17)
- 3. This is the only way we can enter! (Revelation 22:14 NIV)

B. BY BEING SAVED BY GRACE

- 1. This is why Jesus went to the Cross—to shed His blood for our sins
- 2. You Could not be redeemed by anything else! (1 Peter 1:18–19)
- 3. So we could be forgiven and sanctified and saved! (Titus 3:4–7)

C. YOU CAN HAVE THE HOPE OF HEAVEN!

- 1. But Only By the Grace of God and the Blood of the Lamb! (Roman 6:23)
- Jesus said: Unless one is Born Again of the Water and the Spirit, he cannot Enter the Kingdom of God (Jn 3:5)
- 3. When you Believe, Repent, Confess and are Baptized into Christ for the forgiveness of sin you become a Child of God! (Mk 16:16; Ac. 2:38)

 A citizen of heaven! (Phil 3:20)

CONCLUSION:

- 1. The Invitation is open (Revelation 21:6 / 22:17)
- 2. There is room in the kingdom!

But as it is written:

"Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him."

¹⁰ But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. (1 Cor. 2:9-10)
